

Bible Study Fellowship Announces Plan to Move Headquarters to Dallas-Fort Worth Area

Amid Continued US and International Growth, Ministry Seeks Modern Facility and Global Accessibility

SAN ANTONIO, Tx., Feb. 13, 2024 — <u>Bible Study Fellowship</u> (BSF), the internationally-respected ministry providing in-depth Bible studies in more than 120 nations on six continents, today announced its Board of Directors has voted to move the future global location from San Antonio to the Dallas/Ft. Worth area.

"Bible Study Fellowship is a global ministry," said Executive Director of BSF, Hollie Roberts.
"Dallas/Ft. Worth stands out as the right location for the next season in our history for its global accessibility, diverse community, and opportunity to better collaborate with many like-minded ministry partners. The area is also home to a thriving BSF community."

Originally based in Oakland, California, BSF moved to San Antonio in 1980 after a generous donor gave the ministry land to build a headquarters campus.

"God provided our San Antonio home at just the right time as we grew across the U.S. and internationally in Canada, Australia, and England," explained Roberts. "We will always be grateful for our season of ministry in San Antonio, yet through prayer, we are confident that God is leading us to move once again, this time as a means to maximize accessibility to our global audience."

Founded in 1959 by Audrey Wetherell Johnson, who began the ministry as a Bible study with five women at a home in San Bernadino, California, BSF now recognizes more than 400,000 class members worldwide who meet together in-person and online, including men, women, young adults, students, and children. The ministry's proven model for discipleship and biblical engagement is designed to lead group members from a variety of backgrounds and cultures closer to Jesus.

"It will take time to identify the precise location of our new North Texas home," continued Roberts. "We've engaged a commercial real estate broker and are prayerfully considering all options in planning for the new ministry hub. We look forward to establishing a modern and collaborative workspace that honors our rich history and equips BSF for many more decades of ministry."
